## 2012 WALT "LA BRISA" SONOMA COUNTY PINOT NOIR

THE VINEYARDS: This appellation blend is composed of several select vineyards throughout the Russian River Valley: Widdoes, Kozlowski, Martinelli Gregori and the Gap's Crown Vineyard in the Sonoma Coast. The resulting wine is a harmonious chorus of vineyard sites and clones, a complex and delicious Sonoma County blend.

THE WINE: Deep garnet in color, this wine offers a perfume of fig, violets and cinnamon spice. Flavors of cherry coulis and dark spice meld into a broad, full palate with a bright lengthy finish.
